INTRADISTRICT TRANSFERS AND CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS

(LOCAL)

	<p>A student shall be assigned to a school in the attendance area in which he or she resides.</p>
CLASS CHANGES	<p>The campus principal shall be authorized to investigate and approve the transfer of a student from one classroom to another on that campus.</p>
TRANSFERS BETWEEN SCHOOLS	<p>The Superintendent shall be authorized to investigate and approve transfers between schools.</p>
JUNIOR HIGH AND HIGH SCHOOL	<p>An employee who is assigned to a junior high or high school campus may request a transfer for his or her child to attend that campus.</p> <p>If a student's parent is assigned to a high school, the student may enroll in the respective feeder school.</p>
HARDSHIP TRANSFERS	<p>A student shall be allowed to transfer from an assigned school to another school within the District in cases of extreme hardship.</p> <p>Hardship cases shall be approved under the following circumstances:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Denial of transfer would adversely affect the student's mental and/or emotional well-being. (Transfers under this provision shall require a substantiating statement from a qualified doctor in psychology or psychiatry.)2. Denial of transfer would adversely affect the student's physical safety.3. The student's parent presents a building contract or purchase contract verifying a new residence in the requested school zone.
REVOCAION OF TRANSFER	<p>The District has the right to revoke the intradistrict transfer of a student for violating the District's Student Code of Conduct.</p>

Note: For the transfer of a student who is the victim of bullying or who engaged in bullying, see FDB(LEGAL). For the transfer of a student who attends a persistently dangerous school, becomes a victim of a violent criminal offense, or becomes a victim of sexual assault, see FDE.
