Campus and District administrators, as well as school resource officers and District police officers if applicable, may refuse to allow a person to enter or may eject a person from property under the District's control in accordance with law.

District personnel may request assistance from law enforcement in an emergency or when a person is engaging in behavior rising to the level of criminal conduct.

**Off-Campus
Activities**

Employees shall be designated to ensure appropriate conduct of participants and others attending a school-related activity at non-District or out-of-District facilities. Those so designated shall coordinate their efforts with persons in charge of the facilities.

Prohibitions

Tobacco and
E-Cigarettes

The District prohibits smoking and the use of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes); electronic vaping devices; personal vaporizers (PV); or electronic nicotine delivery systems on District property, in District vehicles, and at a school-related or school-sanctioned activity whether on or off District property.

Weapons

The District prohibits the unlawful use, possession, or display of any firearm, location-restricted knife, club, or prohibited weapon, as defined at FNCG, on all District property at all times, except that possession shall be permitted by:

1. A peace officer.
2. A security officer commissioned by the Texas Board of Private Investigators and Private Security Agencies who:
 - a. Is wearing a distinctive uniform;
 - b. Wears the firearm in plain view; and
 - c. Has the written permission of the Superintendent.
3. A security officer who:
 - a. Holds a personal protection authorization under the Private Investigators and Private Security Act, Article 4413 (29bb), Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes; and
 - b. Has the written permission of the Superintendent.

No violation of this policy occurs when:

1. A Texas handgun license holder stores a handgun or other firearm in a locked vehicle in a parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area owned or provided by the District, as long as the handgun or other firearm is not loaded and not in plain view; or

2. The use, possession, or display of an otherwise prohibited weapon takes place as part of a District-approved activity supervised by proper authorities. [See FOD]

Signs

Signs shall be posted in appropriate locations indicating that possession of firearms is prohibited.
