

**No Interdistrict Transfers**

A nonresident student shall not be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.

Exceptions

A resident student who becomes a nonresident during the course of the school year shall be permitted to continue in attendance for the remainder of the school year.

*Child of District Employee*

A nonresident District employee may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuition-free basis. The employee must complete and sign the appropriate transfer forms, including a form stating that the parent and student shall comply with transfer policy procedures and rules.

In approving transfers for a child of a nonresident District employee, the Superintendent shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

*Grandfathered Transfers*

A nonresident student who has been attending school in the District during the 2019–20 school year shall be eligible to apply for an interdistrict transfer. To maintain eligibility to apply for a transfer, the student must maintain continuous enrollment in the District. In approving transfers for a nonresident child who is not the child of a District employee, the Superintendent shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's academic records, disciplinary history, and attendance records.

Transfer Agreements

A grandfathered transfer student shall be notified in the written transfer agreement that he or she must follow all rules and regulations of the District. Violation of the terms of the agreement may result in a transfer request not being approved in future years. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time.

**Transportation**

The District shall not provide transportation for a nonresident student who transfers into the District.

**Tuition**

If the District charges tuition, the amount shall be set by the Board, within statutory limits.

Nonpayment

The District may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.

**Appeals**

Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.
