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| ASSIGNMENT OF
POLICE PERSONNEL | 1. Assignments are determined by the needs of the District at any given time and, therefore, are not permanent. Police personnel are subject to assignment changes when the chief of police, District Police Department, or designee, in consultation with the building principal where applicable, determines that reassignment is necessary. Police personnel may be assigned to regular and overtime duty when necessary. Regular and overtime hours will be determined in accordance with the needs of the District. Hours may vary from employee to employee. |
| OVERTIME | 2. Occasionally the District Police Department personnel may be required to work overtime by either remaining on duty or reporting to duty. Failure of an employee to accept or perform an overtime assignment without a valid reason will be grounds for disciplinary action. |
| CONSULTATION | 3. This regulation has been through consultation (Administrative: August 9, 2005; Noninstructional: September 6, 2005). |
| MAINTENANCE
RESPONSIBILITY | 4. The chief operations officer, Business Operations, is responsible for maintenance of this regulation. |
