ACCIDENTS / ILLNESS OF STUDENTS AT SCHOOL	Procedures established in the <i>Emergency Preparedness Handbook</i> shall be followed when a child is injured or becomes ill at school.
EMERGENCY TREATMENT FORMS	Each year, students and parents shall complete and sign a form that provides emergency information and authorizes school officials to obtain emergency medical treatment, as provided by law.
HEALTH INVENTORY	Each school shall have on file a health inventory of each student, which provides the history of the student's physical, mental, and emotional health up to the time of the student's enrollment in the District.
PURCHASING MEDICATION	The District shall not purchase nonprescription medication to administer to a student.
ADMINISTERING MEDICATION	No employee shall give any student prescription medication, non-prescription medication, herbal substances, anabolic steroids, or dietary supplements of any type, except as provided below.
EXCEPTION	Only authorized employees may administer to students prescription medication with a physician's written request and in accordance with legal requirements and written permission by the parent. [See FFAC(LEGAL)]
PSYCHOTROPICS	Except as permitted by Education Code 38.016, an employee shall not: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Recommend to a student or a parent that the student use a psychotropic drug;</li><li>2. Suggest a particular diagnosis; or</li><li>3. Exclude the student from a class or a school-related activity because of the parent's refusal to consent to psychiatric evaluation or examination or treatment of the student.</li></ol>
