| Driver's Education | Driver's education is taught outside the regular instructional day and is not offered for local credit. Fees for classroom and lab are paid to the business office. |
| Pass / Fail Courses | The District offers no pass/fail courses for state credit. Study hall is offered on a pass/fail basis for local credit. |
| Hunter Education | <p>Hunter education instructors shall be permitted to bring unloaded firearms onto school premises for instructional purposes upon strict compliance with the following procedures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The instructor shall obtain written authorization from the campus principal listing each time a firearm will be brought onto school premises. This authorization shall include both the instructor's and the principal's names and signatures; specify the number, types, and serial numbers of firearms to be used for instructional aids; and indicate when the firearms may be used and when they must be removed from campus.2. The instructor shall carry the authorization when firearms are on school premises.3. A copy of each authorization shall be maintained on file in the campus administrative office.4. The instructor shall ensure that no live ammunition is brought onto school premises. |
| Notification | The principal shall notify local law enforcement officials when a hunter education program is offered at the campus and that instructors are authorized to be in possession of unloaded firearms on school premises. |
