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| <b>UIL Participation</b>    | A student desiring to participate in the UIL athletic program shall undergo a physical examination in accordance with the required schedule established by the UIL and shall submit a statement from an authorized health-care provider indicating that the student has been examined and is physically able to participate in the athletic program. In years that a physical examination is not required, the student shall complete a medical appraisal form. A student may be required to have a physical examination based on answers to the appraisal form. |
| <b>Additional Screening</b> | The District may provide additional screening as District and community resources permit.  |
| <b>Referrals</b>            | Parents of students identified through any screening programs as needing treatment or further examination shall be advised of the need and referred to appropriate health agencies.  |
| Notice of Lice              | A school nurse or administrator who discovers or becomes aware that a child enrolled in a District elementary school has lice shall provide written or electronic notice to parents within the time frames prescribed in law.  |
