

Pass / Fail Courses

The District permits students to take courses on a pass/fail basis only in the following two instances:

1. When the grading system of a student moving into the District is not compatible with the District's grading system, e.g., a student moving in from a foreign country; or
2. When a junior high school student takes a high school level course (Spanish or Algebra I), the student receives a high school credit toward the graduation requirements but a pass or fail mark is entered on the student's transcript and the grade is not counted in calculating class rank.
